Subject: Establishment of Bihar Sports University, Rajgir, Nalanda, Bihar – 803116 – regarding.

Sir,

Kindly refer to letter Ref.No.BSUR/11/2024/65 dated 26.12.2024 and e-mail dated 30.12.2024 on the subject cited above. The university has submitted an attested copy of "Bihar Sports University, Rajgir, Nalanda, Bihar" which has been established by the Bihar Sports University, Rajgir, Nalanda, Bihar Act, 2021 (Bihar Act No.21 of 2021) notified vide Notification No. सं.3/वि. 4-16 / 2021(खण्ड-ग)-2324 dated 20.12.2024 by the Government of Bihar as a State Public University. The Bihar Sports University Act, 2021 (Bihar Act No.21 of 2021) has come into force with effect from 24.02.2023.

Accordingly, the name of the University has been included in the list of Universities established as per Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956. The lists of all the UGC recognized Higher Education Institutions (Universities and Colleges) are uploaded on the UGC website https://www.ugc.gov.in and may be accessed at the tab **HEIs.**

The University may note and adhere to the following:

1. The University is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 by conducting courses through its own departments, its constituent colleges and/or through its affiliated colleges in regular mode only. However, prior approvals for running professional, technical and medical programmes shall be obtained from the respective Regulatory Councils/Commissions. Such programmes are governed by the norms of respective Regulatory Councils/Commissions and the approval of concerned Council/Commission is mandatory.

2. The university shall award only such degrees as specified by the UGC. The University is required to follow the UGC Notification on Specification of Degrees 2014 and its amendments issued from time to time wherein consolidated list of UGC approved nomenclature of degrees has been specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 wherein entry level of each degree and duration of programme have been provided. The approved nomenclature may be followed by the specific area of specialization to be reflected in the parentheses. This notification is available on the UGC website www.ugc.gov.in under the link https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/1061840 specification-of-degrees-july-2014.pdf

3. The University shall operate only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the State of its location. The University is not allowed to start any off-camp is centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction as provided in the Act and under no circumstances beyond the State of

its location, as per the Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Prof. Yash Pal vs. State of Chhattisgarh.

4. No Open and Distance Learning programmes and on-line programmes shall be started without the prior and specific approval of UGC. Relevant UGC Regulations are available on the UGC website www.ugc.gov.in.

5. The University must ensure that there is no franchising of higher education even for the purpose of distance education. In case the university has already started any off-campus/study centre and centre operating through franchises outside the State, it must be closed immediately.

6. The University shall follow University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022, and as amended from time to time.

- 7. The University shall immediately appoint an Ombudsperson in accordance with UGC (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023 for redressal of grievances of students preferably within two months of starting academic activities. The UGC (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023 is available on the UGC website at link https://www.ugc.gov.in/pdfnews/4675881_Regulation.pdf. The details of Ombudsperson should be displayed on the website of university and sent to UGC also.
- 8. The University shall follow UGC guidelines on Public Self Disclosure by Higher Education Institutions which are available on UGC website at the link-https://www.ugc.gov.in/pdfnews/7822003_GUIDELINES-ON-PUBLIC-SELF-DISCLOSURE-BY-HIGHER-EDUCATION-INSTITUTIONS.pdf.

9. The university shall get necessary accreditations from the NAAC.

- 10. The university shall register and upload the information of all students on Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) and National Academic Depository (NAD) portals of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.
- 11. The University shall follow all the applicable UGC Regulations, Guidelines notified and available on UGC website www.ugc.gov.in.
